

FAQs to NINE for Students



Why do I need NINE for my studies?

Via NINE I can register for lectures, consultation-hours, events and newsletters. That's how I always stay up to date. My lecturers, the student council and the student office also send a lot of information via NINE.

How do I get access to NINE?

Before I use NINE for the first time, I have to register. I can choose a username and password. A validation e-mail will be sent to the given e-mail address, which I then have to confirm.

Which e-mail address should I use for registration?

As a student, I should use my hm.edu e-mail address. Many departments of the HM (e.g. Examinations Office) send important information to this address.

Students get the hm.edu e-mail address the day after enrollment. So first please check the access to the e-mail account and then register with NINE.

What happens if I state a different e-mail address?

With a different e-mail address, I only get a guest access. Although I can see timetables, I can only register in consultation-hours, but not in lectures or newsletters.

By entering my hm.edu e-mail address, I can always change my user account to the status "Student".

What happens if I don't reply to the validation e-mail?

If I don't answer, my account will automatically be deactivated and deleted after 14 days.

Do I have to register for courses?

No, but it is recommended. Only when I sign up for a course, I get information. For some courses, there are only a limited number of places. Here I have to register when I want to participate. In some cases, there are also place raffles (see the topic "Place raffle" in the NINE user guideline).

In general, a registration in a course is not a seat reservation or something similar! When in doubt, always talk directly to the lecturer. He/she takes the decision.

Why do I have to specify the course of studies in my user profile?

The information appear on the participant lists of the courses and are used as a filter for sending information, e.g. for informative meetings for first-semester students or to choose the field of study.

Do I have to provide the details of the course of studies every semester?

Yes.

When I can inscribe for courses?

The faculty sends an e-mail to inform you.
