Application procedure and period

Step 1:

Nomination by the international officer of the sending partner institution by mail to international.socialwork@arteveldehs.be; before 01/05/2019

- data and selection of the student
- confirmation that the student meets the specific requirements (advanced level and language skills B2)

Step 2:

Application by the student by mail to international.socialwork@arteveldehs.be; before 01/05/2019

Information: student’s name, first name, place and date of birth, address, mail address

Required documents:

- CV
- Motivation letter with answer to the following questions
Why studying abroad and specific this programme?
What challenges are there to face?
How does the ‘Social Work in Urban Areas- programme’ contributes to the student’s competences?
- Official transcript of records in English

Step 3:

Acceptation of nomination.

The student as well as the sending partner will receive a mail to accept the student(s).

Step 4: Students register online !

ultimate deadline for online registration - **15/05/2019**
