During winter term 2020/2021 we are starting with the new courses of the 5th semester (examination regulations SPO 3.0) in our bachelor's programme "Tourism Management"

The 5th semester is our „International Semester“: The idea is to offer all students staying in Munich an English taught course programme, which will also address the international aspects of tourism in more detail. There are many advantages with this new concept such as

- Better implementation of the MUAS strategy „Internationalization@home“ which provides Munich students not studying abroad an international perspective on tourism issues
- Better and closer integration of our incoming students (of our partner universities) in the regular course programme
- Facilitation of exchange between incoming and regular Munich students.

All regular students are assigned to a class labelled A, B, C or D (e.g. 5B).

For international students: For courses split up into smaller groups (see table below), please go to the classes labeled 5A to 5D in the time table (day) according to the first letter of your last name: Group 5A: A-F; 5B: G-L; 5C: M-R; 5D: S-Z. Groups A & B and C & D are often taught within the same class.

As some regular students are outgoings, some doing their internships, the normal class size (groups A, B, C, D) is unpredictable. Therefore, the groups might be merged in some of the courses, which can lead to changes in your timetable. So please refer to the class schedule.
